Her lampshade makers' work can be seen in The Royal Opera House, Soho House, numerous restaurants throughout London and palaces in the Middle East, whilst the fabrics for them are sourced from her own library. The sculpted lamps are cast in a rural studio in Surrey where both TV and film props are made as well as important large sculptural works.

Last month the lamps were launched at an exclusive event hosted by Boodles in New Bond Street.

"The feedback was amazing - some said they felt the lamps were an inspiring mix of art and practicality. They seemed to evoke stories and

emotional reactions which was wonderful to see and hear."

Looking at the lamps close up it is clear to see what Katherine means. The drama of the pieces gives them all an individual presence and any one of them would be perfectly placed as a statement accent in any scheme. There is an uninhabited, playful rawness about them which allows one to feel immediately connected.

Katherine is unpretentious about them and seems to simply enjoy seeing the look on the people's faces when they discover them for the first time.
